

## **London to Brighton Cycle Ride**

## Sunday 11th September 2022

## Dear Resident

The 12th edition of the Skyline London to Brighton Cycle Ride on Sunday 11th September 2022 will see thousands of riders completing the challenging 55-mile ride from Clapham Common, through south London, Surrey, West & East Sussex to the Brighton finish on Madeira Drive - in the process raising over £1 million for a wide variety of good causes.

The event starts on Clapham Common at 06:00 travelling south through Carshalton and into Surrey, where road closures will be in place on Hazelwood Lane, Markedge Lane, Rocky Lane, Cormongers Lane, Fullers Wood Lane and Clay Lane in the vicinity of Chipstead, Merstham and Nutfield, in case you are planning to travel through the area on the day.

The event travels south on open roads through West Sussex via Turners Hill, with traffic control in place on the B2028 Turners Hill Road to allow cyclists to turn right into Wallage Lane and traffic light control at the crossroads in Turners Hill which will be very busy at peak times and delays should be expected from 07:00 to 15:00.

The route continues south through Ardingly and Haywards Heath to reach the famous climb over Ditchling Beacon, which is closed throughout the day to give riders access to Brighton. The roads along length of the route will be busier than usual, delays are likely travelling in the direction of cyclists and alternative routes should allow easier access.

The first cyclists arrive in Brighton by 08:30 with the final cyclists starting at 10:30 with the goal of reaching the finish line by 18:00.
